St. Augustine Alligator Farm Zoological Park

Description:	The Alligator Farm is a modern zoo that focuses primarily on reptiles. It exhibits living specimens of all 24 currently recognized species of crocodilian. There is a wading bird rookery nestled among the alligators where birds actively roost, nest, and raise their young. The wild visiting birds are attracted to the facility because the presence of the alligators keeps the nests safe from tree climbing predators. The elevated boardwalk through the rookery allows visitors to get an intimate view of these nesting birds. Photographers regularly get award winning photos at this location. The best time to visit is during nesting season from March through June.
	Birds are in their breeding plumage and actively nesting.
